that at a meeting of the Council of the Borough of North Plainfield held on April 13, 2026 there was introduced and read for the first time, and passed on such first reading, an ordinance, a true copy whereof is printed below and that said Council did then and there fix the regular meeting of said Council to be held on April 27, 2026 at 7:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, and the North Plainfield Borough Council Chambers, 263 Somerset Street, North Plainfield, New Jersey or via Zoom as the place when and where said ordinance will be further considered for final passage, at which time and place, or at any time and place to which such meeting shall from time to time be adjourned, all persons interested will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning such ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 26-05

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, REVISE AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 7 OF THE BOROUGH CODE, ENTITLED "TRAFFIC," MOST NOTABLY, SECTION 7-15.1, ENTITLED "HANDICAPPED PARKING ON STREET" AND CHAPTER 7A OF THE BOROUGH CODE, ENTITLED "TRAFFIC SCHEDULES", MOST NOTABLY SCHEDULE XXI, ENTITLED "HANDICAPPED PARKING".

WHEREAS, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 39:4-8(c)(1)*, the governing body of a municipality may make, amend, repeal and/or enforce such ordinances as it may deem necessary and proper for the prohibition or restriction of parking as may be necessary to carry into effect the powers and duties conferred and imposed by Chapter 7 of the Borough Code, or by any other law; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 39:4-197*, the governing body of a municipality may make, amend, repeal and/or enforce such ordinances as it may deem necessary and proper for the provision of designated parking for people with disabilities; and,

WHEREAS, after proper investigation, the North Plainfield Police Department has determined that parking at or about 66-68 Duer Street meets the criteria for an on-street handicapped stall; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough therefore finds it necessary and appropriate to amend, revise and supplement Schedule XXI of the Borough Code, more specifically Section 7A-21, to implement such designated handicapped parking restrictions as aforesaid, in conjunction with the provisions of Section 7-15.1 of the Borough Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that the Borough Code of the Borough of North Plainfield be amended, revised and supplemented as to Chapter 7 of the Borough Code, entitled "Traffic," most notably Section 7-15.1, entitled "Handicapped Parking on Street" and Chapter 7A of the Borough Code, entitled "Traffic Schedules", more specifically "Schedule XXI, Handicapped Parking," by the addition(s) as follows:

Name of Street	Side	Location
<u>Duer Street</u>	<u>East</u>	<u>Beginning at a point forty-seven (47) feet south of the extended curb line of Mercer Avenue and extending twenty-two (22) feet therefrom.</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect, after final passage, twenty (20) days following action or inaction by the Mayor as provided by law or an override of a mayoral veto by the Council, whichever is applicable and publication in

accordance with law, unless a Resolution is adopted, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40:69A-181(b)*, declaring an emergency and providing that this Ordinance shall take effect at an earlier date.
