MARRIAGE LICENSE APPLICATIONS

You must schedule an appointment to apply for your marriage license.

The couple must have the following when they apply:

- Valid Driver's License or **passport**** for each applicant
- One witness, 18 years of age or older with valid ID
- \$28 CASH (*exact change is required*)
- Date and location of the wedding ceremony
- Name and phone number of the officiant

****If using a *passport*, one of the following must be provided to establish address:**

- Voter registration
- Utility bill or Bank Statement (within the previous 90 days)
- W-2 or tax return for current or previous year

The following documents are helpful, but not required:

- A copy of your birth certificate to establish your parents' names
- Decrees or annulment documents if you are divorced, have had a previous civil union dissolved, domestic partnership terminated or have had a civil union annulled
- Death Certificate if your former spouse/civil union or domestic partner is deceased.

The marriage license application is valid for six months from the date accepted. Once the application process has been completed, there is a minimum 72-hour waiting period before the license can be issued. Upon issuance, the license is good for 30 days. If the license expires before being used, a new application must be completed with the required fee.
